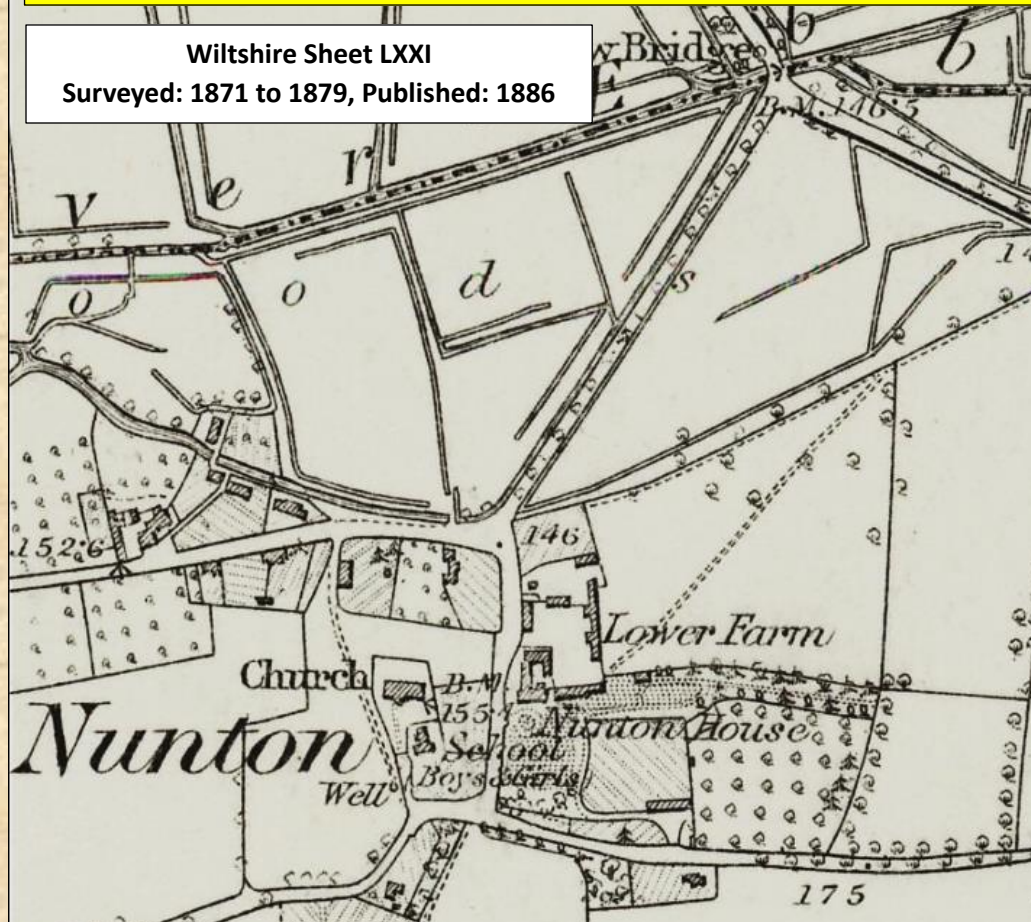

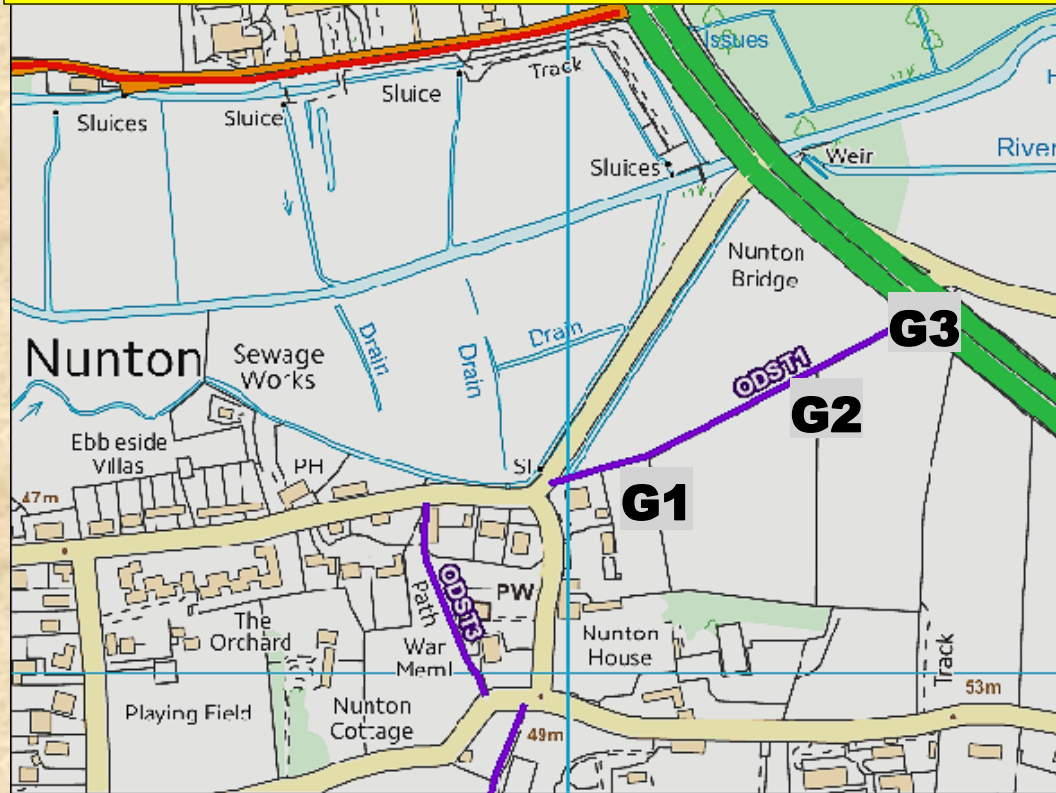


River Ebbel Flood Plain

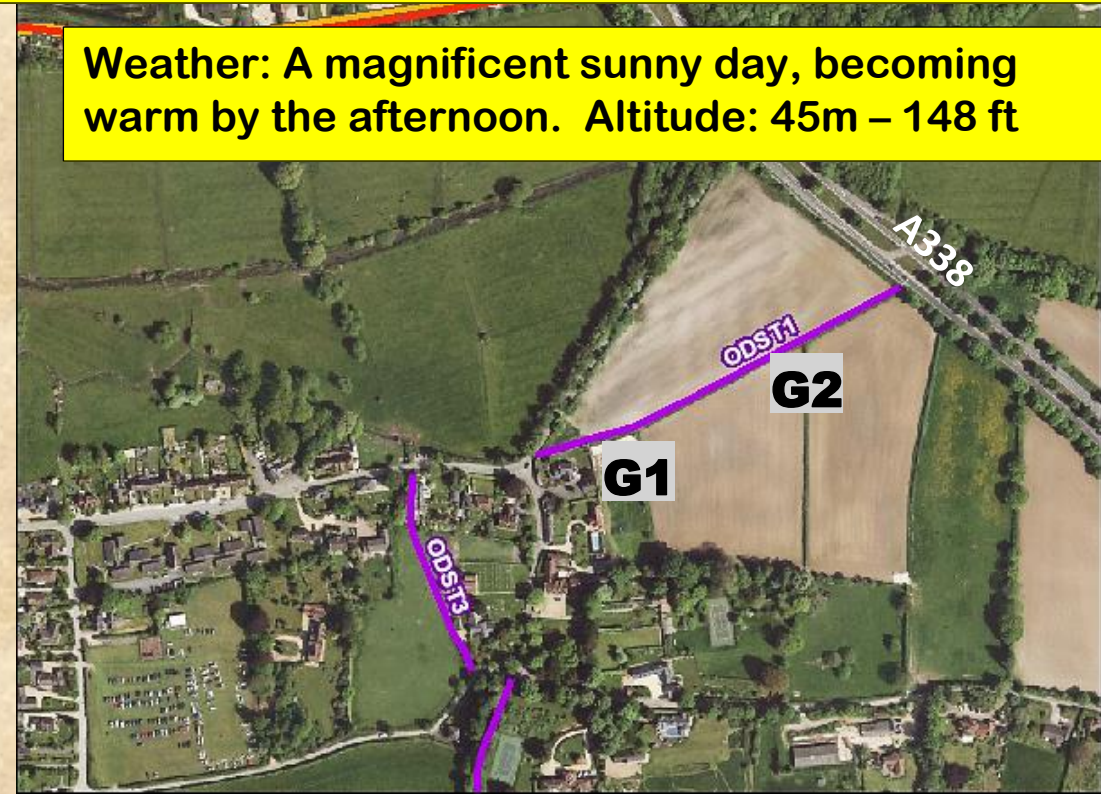

Weather: A magnificent sunny day, becoming warm by the afternoon. Altitude: 45m – 148 ft

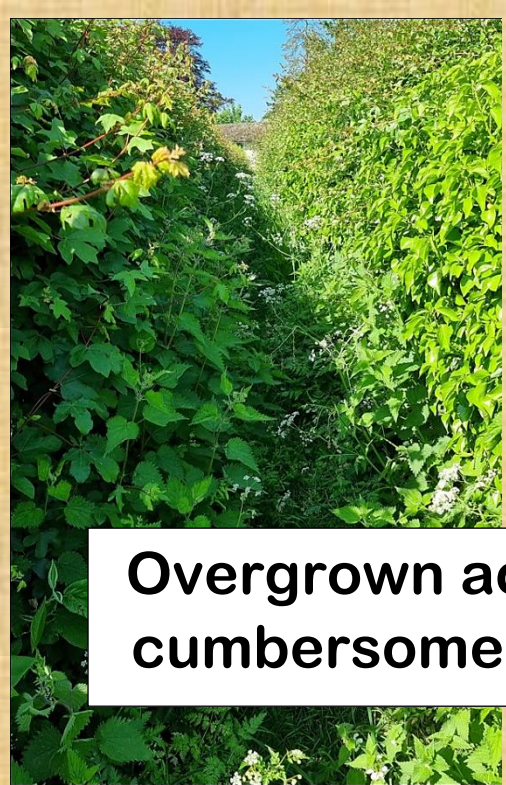


Morning Session:

- ✓ Installing 3 metal hooped pedestrian gates (G1, G2 and G3) on footpath ODS11
- ✓ Clearing overgrown vegetation near the access and exit of this short footpath

Overgrown access; old cumbersome stile/step

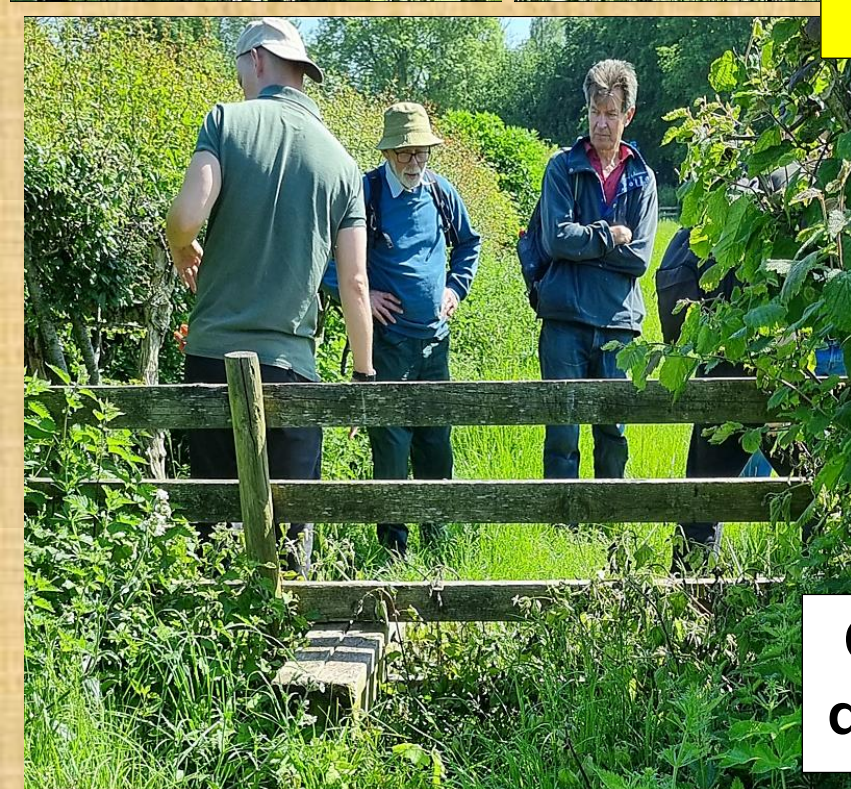


Stile 1

Alex outlines the plan for the installation of new hooped gates at all 3 sites.

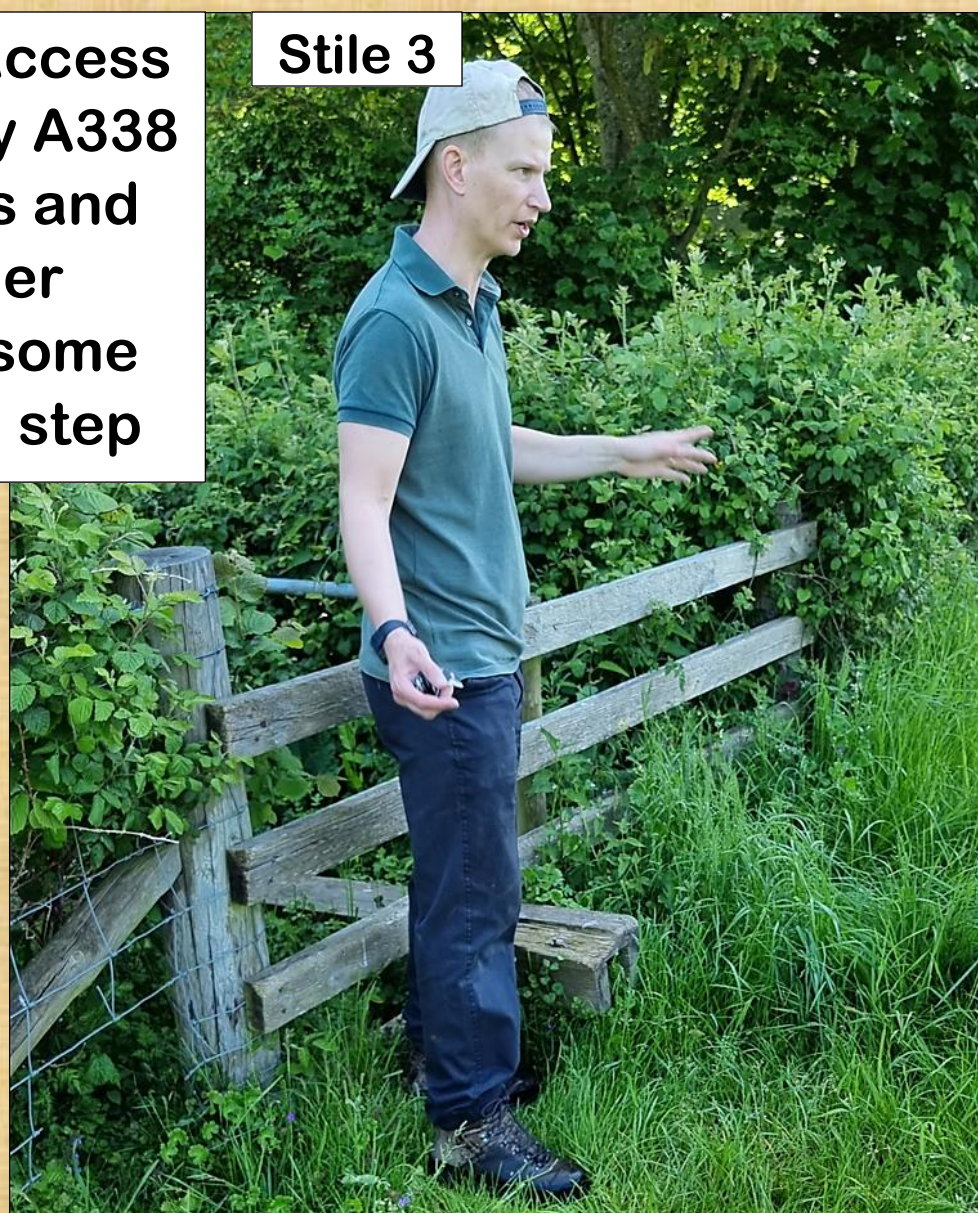

Team 1 - Gate 1



Check gate closes



Remove wood fencing/stile, address gate H frame and hoops to the site and locate where holes and trench must be dug to 'fix' structure with cement aggregate and tamp down and cover with soil.

Access behind cleared



A great job team! Well Done!

Team 2 - Gate 2





The same procedure for Pedestrian Gate 2: remove the old stile; prepare the site by digging appropriate holes, drop gate and hoop frame in; concrete in and tamp down. Reinststate soil surface and level off. Finally clear off overgrown vegetation near access.
